### Market Return Analyzer | Python, Pandas, NumPy, Time-Series Analysis

- Built a Python-based market return analysis tool to compute daily returns, volatility, and return distributions from historical price data, enabling data-driven insights into market risk and behavior.

### Weather Forecasting | Python, Pandas, NumPy, PyTorch, Time-Series Forecasting

December 2025

- Built an end-to-end pipeline using public hourly weather data (Open-Meteo) to predict next-day temperature with sliding-window features and time-based splits.
- Trained and evaluated LSTM/1D-CNN models against naive baselines using MAE/RMSE and prediction-vs-actual plots for error analysis.
